- ❑ Regionalization incentives \$40K per added county
- ❑ Flat funding
- ❑ Scope creep plus aging demographic

County levy in ADRC is for indirect costs. The county is actually only paying 62 cents on every dollar because we recover 38 cents from Federal match!

- ❑ 300+ program volunteers
- ❑ Home visits
- ❑ Central kitchen
- ❑ Delivery vehicles w/indoor storage
- ❑ 22 MOW delivery routes (9 paid & 13 volunteer)
- ❑ Trust account
- ❑ Community & other garden projects
- ❑ 9 meal sites
- ❑ Revitalization grants totaling \$30K in last two years successfully increasing participation in dining center meals
- ❑ 3-4 Interns every year

Transportation

- AddLIFE Transit (1 minibus & 5 minivans)
- Contract w/Volunteer Services of Barron Co.
- Contract w/Rice Lake City Cab
- Contracts w/other providers
- Coordination w/other services

Funding

- Operations & Contracting state DOT 85.21 allocation
- Vehicle acquisition State/Fed DOT 5310 competitive grants
- County match
- Passenger co-pays
- Contract w/CCCW
- Trust account

Transportation continued

Miscellaneous

- Spending must be done in a specific order.
- Gas purchased through county
- Indoor storage for vehicles
- Coordination w/Namekagon Transit
- 3 vehicles awarded in 2015.
- 2 vehicles awarded in 2016.
- Just submitted application for 2 vehicles in 2017

State 85.21 funds come from fuel tax, registration fee & borrowing...same segregated fund that supports roads, bridges, harbors, airports, pedestrian, bicycle, mass transit!

Homemaker & Personal Care

- Required to provide some type of in-home supportive services
- Cleaning of bathroom & kitchen 1 x/month
- Personal care/bathing 1 x/ week

Miscellaneous

- ❑ Services provided for 6 months*
- ❑ Suggested donation per visit
- ❑ Contract w/ Indianhead Home Services
- ❑ Not available to persons on FamilyCare/IRIS

* Like other services, our intent is to provide a little help to a lot of people. This program is designed to help people recognize the benefit of spending a little in order to stay in their home longer.
