



***Fifty Years and Forward:
Building Upon the UW-BC Legacy***

The John Meggers Era 1966-88



-  Hired as **Founding Dean** by “Wisconsin State University - Stout” to lead design and formation of Barron County branch campus (1965)
-  **First professor/educators hired** and classes begin at Anne Street School, the former Barron County Teachers College (1966)
-  **Construction** of the new \$3,000,000 campus begins on Johnson-Zimmer farm land tract (1967)
-  **Classes begin at the new campus** and the first commencement ceremony is held in May (1968)





- UW Dean during **extreme budget shortfalls** in the UW Centers leading to many faculty dispersed to other campuses and Medford campus closing (1980)
- UW Established **First BCC Foundation**
- UW Established Annual **Holiday Angel Ball**
- UW **“King of the liberal and fine arts”** and founder of The Dean’s List Big Band
- UW Brought **first international students** to campus
- UW Wide array of thriving campus **sports & clubs**




Dr. John Meggers Era 1966-88

Dr. Mary Somers Era 1988-97




- Created **first ITV Classroom** and began actively delivering UW-BCC courses to high schools
- Strong **advocate for UW liberal arts programming**, including the annual **Humanities Day Event**
- **Expanded teaching spaces** into Student Center to accommodate growing enrollments
- Promoted **professional development** for faculty & staff
- Added **evening and weekend classes** for AAS
- **Upgrading of technology** in classrooms across campus from overhead projectors to computers
- Focused on **building gender equality**, hiring an increasing number of female faculty and staff
- She was a **true “New Yorker”** and brought the “Beyond Broadway Series” and “Golf Tournament” to campus to raise funds for the UW-BCC Foundation
- Created a **visionary campus facilities plan** that laid the ground work for 2006 building project

Dr. Paul Chase Era 1997-2013



- **Enhanced partnerships & relationships with WITC and UW partner campuses (Superior Access)**
- **Expansion of ITV to 5 classrooms serving more than 150 high school students per semester**
- **Encouraged faculty teaching online and split faculty positions with new UW Colleges Online**
- **\$5.5 million Campus expansion and enhancement of Ritzinger and Meggers Halls (2006)**
- **New science labs and technology in all classrooms**



Dr. Paul Chase Era 1997-2013

- **Co-Developed the ESFY Program** and taught LEC 100
- Encouraged **interdisciplinary course development** beyond that of most other UW Colleges campuses
- **Advocated for UW-BC to offer BAAS** degrees – one of five UW College campuses in program
- One of three UW Colleges campuses to pilot **Integrated Enrollment Management (IEM)** model to develop campus funding reserves and special programs
- **Achieved excellent community relations** and grew UW-BC Foundation Support & Promoted EATS Event



- **Enhanced partnerships & relationships** with WITC, UW-Superior, UW-EC, and LCO Ojibwa College
- Increased face-to-face **outreach to regional high schools** in Northwest Wisconsin
- **Expansion of ITV** and other course new delivery modes to over 200 HS students per semester
- UW Assistance in creating and designing **North Cedar Academy** in Ladysmith
- **Renovation of Student Center & New Bookstore**



Dr. Dean Yohnk “Era” 2013-15

- UW Collaborative development of UW-BC’s first **academic plan** focused on enhanced recruitment and retention of students
- UW **Promotion of the BAAS** in region and realization of first graduates
- UW **\$5.25+ million Campus HVAC** Renovation & Energy Saving Project
- UW Established **International Coordinator positions** and encouraged the **enrollment of international** and US diverse students
- UW **UW-BC Foundation** raises \$200,000+ via EATS, U-Fest, Donations
- UW Active engagement of campus in design and implementation of the **UW Colleges’ BISC regionalization** and consolidation process




- UW UW-BC is a **“best buy” with affordable tuition** allowing students to save 50% or more on total college costs.


