


PARENT EDUCATION ORDER

Pursuant to Sec. 767.401(1) of the Wisconsin statutes, the Court **ORDERS** you to attend a class concerning the effects on a child of a dissolution of the marriage. You cannot get divorced until both parents have attended. If one parent fails to complete the class, that parent is subject to contempt of court. If you have children under the age of 18, you are required by the Barron County Circuit Court to attend an educational session concerning the effects on a child of dissolution of a marriage. You may take the class online and proof of completion must be on file with the Clerk of Court before your final hearing.

You may choose the session that best fits your schedule. You do not have to attend the same session as your child's other parent.

The sessions are educational, highlighting the most common situations experienced by children who do not live with both parents at the same time. A better, less stressful method for handling each situation is explained and modeled for parents.

The goals are to help sensitize parents to their children's distress, and to learn techniques to avoid putting the children in the middle.
