1. Zoned Townships : Almena, Barron, Cedar Lake, Clinton, Crystal Lake, Cumberland, Dallas, Doyle, Maple Grove, Maple Plain, Oak Grove, Prairie Lake, Rice Lake, Stanford, Stanley, Sumner, Turtle Lake
2. Unzoned Townships : Arland, Bear Lake, Chetek, Dovre, Lakeland, Prairie Farm, Sioux Creek, Vance Creek  
Zoning authority in an unzoned township is limited to the shoreland protection area, which is all land within 1,000 feet of a lake and/or 300 feet of rivers, streams or creeks.
3. Type I Mining - Governmental use only/1 year time limit.
4. Operational Plan - presented to the Board of Adjustment (BOA) at the public hearing for Special Exception
5. Request for Public Hearing - Published in local newspaper for 30 days and notice sent to property owners within 300' of proposed mining property.  
A public hearing will be held when a written request is received.
